Application and Decision Dates for admission to the 2025/2026 school year

The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	6th January 2025
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	28th January 2025 @12 noon
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	18th February 2025
The date by which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is *	25th February 2025

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.
