## Application and Decision Dates for admission to the 2025/2026 school year

The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	6 <sup>th</sup> January 2025
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	28 <sup>th</sup> January 2025 @12 noon
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	18 <sup>th</sup> February 2025
The date by which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is *	25 <sup>th</sup> February 2025

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.
